"Mom, your oatmeal is almost better than it is in Phasieland!" Phasie blurted out during breakfast; by now he nearly always wanted to talk about his night travels.

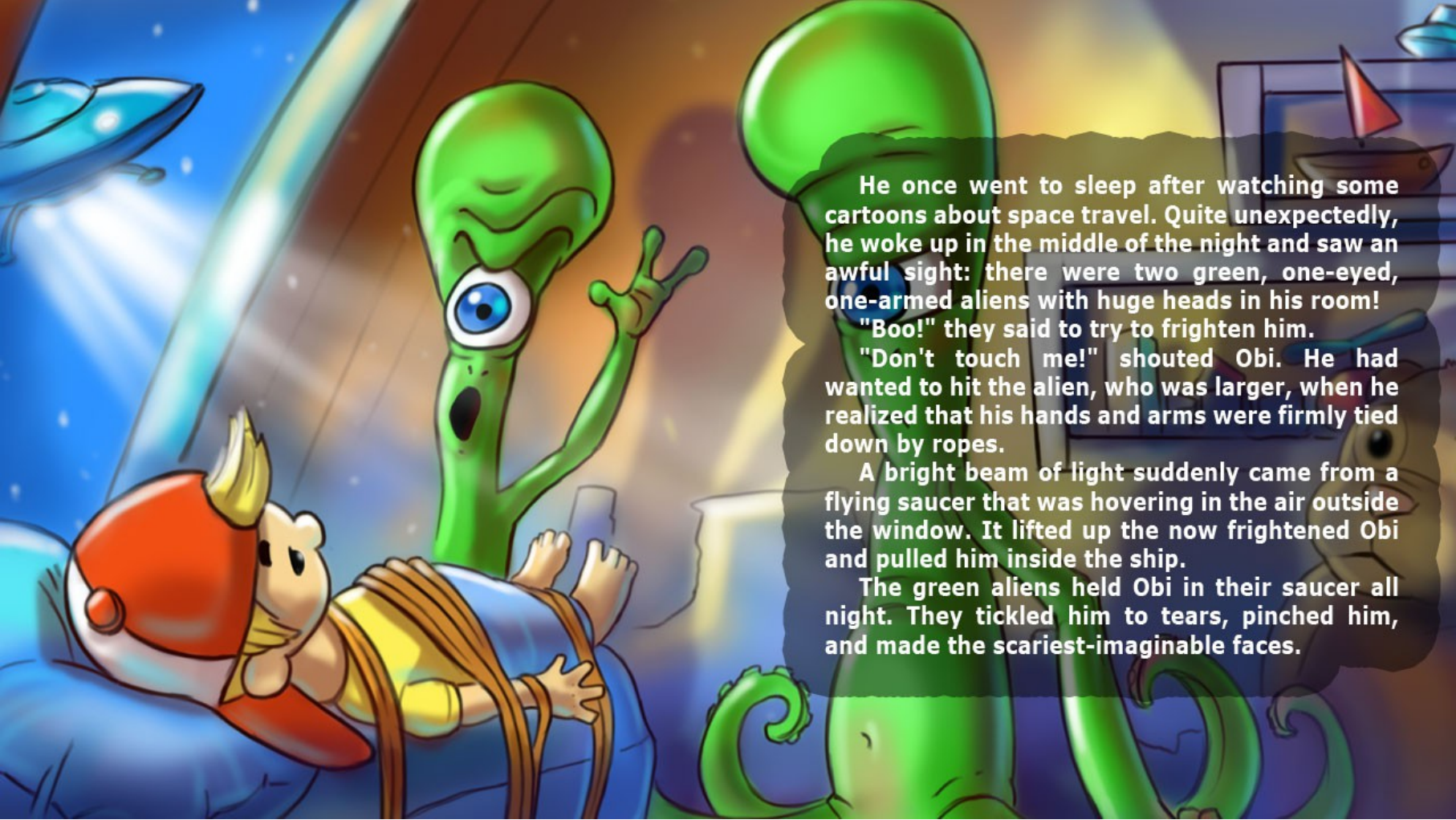
"There you go on again about your dreams..."

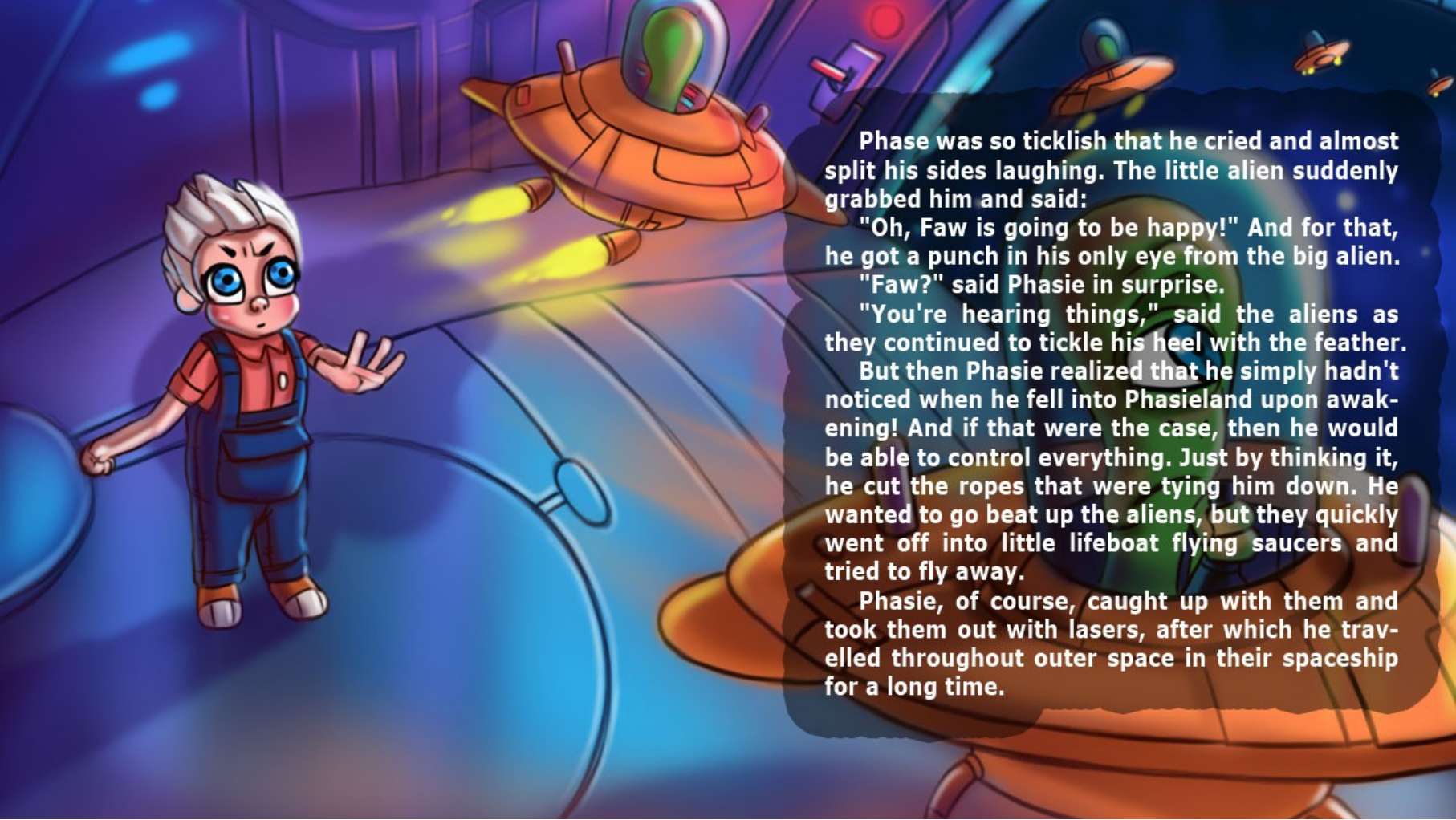
"Boo!" We're going to tickle and pinch you all night!" said the big alien.

But Phasie wouldn't let it go:


"All of these nighttime miracles and awful experiences are cooked up for people by Faw and his minions. It's not real aliens or ghosts!"
